

# Fabio Masini

## PROFILE

Fabio Masini graduated in *Economics* from the University of Florence in 1992 and was awarded a PhD in the *History of Economic Thought* in 1997. During and after a post-doc degree at the University of Pisa he worked as project manager and consultant for major companies and public administrations on projects of local development.

From 2005 to 2010 he was *Assistant Professor of Political Economy* at the University of Roma Tre, then *Associate* and later *Full Professor* of History of Economic Thought. He teaches *Theories and History of International Political Economy* and *European Project Management* and holds a *Jean Monnet Chair on European Economic Governance*.

He was visiting scholar at *Hitotsubashi University* Tokyo and is *Managing Editor* of the journal *History of Economic Thought and Policy*. He was Secretary General and Vice-President of the *European Movement* in Italy and is Secretary General of the *Robert Triffin International*.

He was a member of several National Research Projects and *Academic Coordinator* of a few European Projects (UrEU, 2014-15; EURef, 2019-21; EU2, 2020-22; Consulting EUTH, 2022-24, KA-220 ILO, 2022-24; EUTeach, 2022-25; EUPress 2022-25).

Main fields of research: European and international economic and monetary integration; economic policy and public intervention in the economy.
